Dates for the Awards

- Voting in the Great Australian Fish & Chip Awards opens Monday, November 21, 2022 at 12:01am AEDT and closes on Tuesday, December 13 at 11:59pm AEDT for all states and territories. This timeframe is known as the “voting period”.
- State Winners will be announced on Thursday, December 15, 2022. This is known as the “winner announcement”.
- Dates are subject to change. Any changes to the voting period or winner announcement dates will be communicated via the website at www.fishandchipawards.com.au

SIA reserves the right to change or amend the date of the awards or announcement of winners at any time and without warning.

Voting process - People’s Choice

The rules of the Great Australian Fish & Chip Awards for the People’s Choice is a public vote of one vote, per person, per state/territory, per calendar day (AEDT). All votes must come from a valid email address linked to the person voting. SIA reserves the right to review any and all votes for irregularities and will remove any votes that do not comply with the rules, or which have been submitted from an invalid or fraudulent email address. Vote data is kept for record keeping purposes.

Voting is permitted via www.fishandchipawards.com.au only. All votes must be linked to a valid email address. The People’s Choice Award is chosen by the public who can nominate and vote for their favourite store at www.fishandchipawards.com.au. A winner will be named for each Australian State/Territory (Australian Capital Territory, New South Wales, Northern Territory, Queensland, South Australia, Tasmania, Victoria and Western Australia) based on the store which receives the most valid votes during the voting period. The decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

The winner of the Fish & Chips Awards in each state will receive a trophy. There is no monetary award or prize money associated with the Great Australian Fish & Chip Awards.
